

COUNCIL CHAMBERS, JANUARY 25, 1937

The four hundred thirty-fifth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 25th day of January, 1937.

The meeting was called to order by President of the Council Burdick. Present: Councilmen Burdick, Mourer and Wills, Water Superintendent Bevington, Fire Chief Lewellyn and Recorder Adams.

L S Carter appeared before the Council and requested the Council to adjust the Sewer Assessments against his property on Myrtle Street. Consideration of the request was postponed until the next meeting.

The Recorder requested authority to purchase a warrant registry and new warrants. It was moved by Mourer and seconded by Wills that the Recorder be authorized to purchase a warrant registry and new warrants. Motion carried and so ordered.

Water Superintendent Bevington requested authority to purchase meter parts to the extent of \$24.85. It was moved by Wills and seconded by Mourer that the authority be granted. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Wills and seconded by Mourer that the Recorder prepare and post an ordinance providing that hereafter new water users be required to make a deposit of \$3.00 as a condition to the water being turned on. Motion carried and so ordered.
