

COUNCIL CHAMBERS, APRIL 12, 1937

The four hundred fortieth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 12th day of April, 1937.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sanders. Present: Mayor Sanders, Councilmen Burdick, Dell, Maurer and Roberts, Water Superintendent Bevington, Fire Chief Lewellyn, Marshal Elsing and Recorder Adams.

The minutes of the four hundred thirty-eighth and of the four hundred thirty-ninth regular meetings of the Council held respectively on the 8th and 22nd day of March, 1937 were each read and were each approved as read.

The Treasurer's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

The Fire Chief's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

City Engineer Jones submitted the following recommendation on the furnishing of a booster pump to the Water Department:

"I have selected and recommend for you to obtain Worthington Co. Monoblock Type D E 7½ H.P. pump as submitted by the bid of Harry A. Brod in the sum of \$265.00. This fulfills the requirements as set forth in the call for bids."

It was moved by Roberts and seconded by Dell that the bid of \$265.00 submitted by Harry Brod for the furnishing of a booster pump to the water department be accepted. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Dell that Water Superintendent Bevington be authorized to purchase the necessary fittings relative to the installation of the booster pump for the Water Department. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance Number 376 entitled: "An Ordinance prescribing rates on water, effective July 1, 1937, and repealing Ordinance No. 368, and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith." was read for the first time.

Ordinance Number 377 entitled: "An Ordinance to regulate and license certain mechanical amusement devices commonly known and referred to as "pin ball machines" under Chapter 369, Laws 1935, State of Oregon, and to repeal ordinance No. 353" was read for the first time.

It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Dell that the following bills be approved and that the Recorder issue warrants covering the same.
