

COUNCIL CHAMBERS, APRIL 26, 1937

The four hundred forty-first regular meeting of the Council was held on the 26th day of April, 1937.

The meeting was called to order by President of the Council Burdick. Present: Councilmen Burdick, Dell Maurer and Roberts; Water Superintendent Bevington, Fire Chief Lewellyn, Marshal Elsing and Recorder Adams.

Ordinance Number 376 entitled "An Ordinance prescribing rates on water, effective July 1, 1937, and repealing Ordinance No. 368 and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith." was taken up and read for the second time. It was moved by Dell and seconded by Roberts that the ordinance be amended by making the outside rate \$2.50 per two months period. Motion carried and so ordered. The ordinance as amended was read for the third time and put on its passage with following result being had: Ayes - Burdick, Dell, Maurer and Roberts. Noes: None. Ordinance Number 376 passed the Council.

Ordinance Number 377 entitled "An Ordinance to regulate and license certain mechanical amusement devices commonly known and referred to as "pin ball machines" under Chapter 369, Laws 1935, State of Oregon, and to repeal ordinance No. 353" was read for the second time. It was moved by Roberts and seconded by Dell that the words and figures Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) appearing in Section 5 be amended to read fifteen dollars (\$15.00). Motion carried and so ordered. Ordinance Number 377 was read for the third time as amended and put on its passage with the following result being had. Ayes: Dell, Maurer and Roberts. Ordinance Number 377 passed the Council.

The Recorder brought up the question of the request of P.W.A. authorities that the machinery be gotten under way for the calling of

a special election for the purpose of submitting to the voters the question of voting bonds for the construction of a new city hall. It was moved by Dell and seconded by Roberts that the Recorder prepare and post an ordinance calling for a special election on June 28, 1937 for the purpose of submitting to the voters of Milwaukie for their acceptance or rejection of a proposal to issue \$17,000.00 general obligation bonds with which to supply funds to erect, construct, build and furnish a city hall. Motion carried and so ordered.

Upon motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
