

COUNCIL CHAMBERS, MAY 10, 1937

The four hundred forty -second regular meeting of the Council was held on the 10th day of May, 1937.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sanders. Present: Mayor Sanders, Councilmen Burdick, Dell, Mourer and Roberts; Water Superintendent Bevington, Fire Chief Lewellyn and Recorder Adams.

The minutes of the four hundred fortieth and four hundred forty-first regular meetings of the Council held respectively on the 12th and 26th days of April, 1937 were each read and were each approved as read.

The Treasurer's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

The Fire Chief's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

Councilman Burdick reported that it would cost \$186.40 to widen the curve of the roadway where Main Street joins Lake Road. It was moved by Dell and seconded by Burdick that \$186.40 be appropriated out of the street fund for the purpose of widening and improving the curve where Main Street runs into Lakeroad. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mary Rader and Harold Sellwood appeared before the Council in reference to lots 17 and 18, Block 12, Quincy Addition. Mrs. Rader offered to redeem the property for \$173.24. It was moved by Dell and seconded by Burdick that the offer be accepted. Motion carried and so ordered.

The matter of applying for a WPA project for further replacing two inch galvanized water mains with larger cast iron pipe and installing fire hydrants was discussed. It was moved by Burdick and seconded by Dell that the Water Superintendent furnish estimates and plans for the proposed improvement at the next meeting and that the matter be layed on the table until that time. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Burdick that the Portland Open Air Sanatorium be sent a statement in the amount of \$50.00 to cover services of Fire Department at a fire on the Sanatorium's premises on May . Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Roberts that the following bills be approved and that the Recorder issue warrants covering the same.
