

COUNCIL CHAMBERS, JUNE 14, 1937

The four hundred forty-fourth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 14th day of June, 1937.

The meeting was called to order by President of the Council Burdick. Present: Councilmen Burdick, Dell, Mourer and Roberts; Water Superintendent Bevington, Fire Chief Lewellyn and Recorder Adams.

The minutes of the four hundred forty-second and four hundred forty-third regular meetings of the Council held respectively on the 10th and 24th days of May, 1937 were each read and were each approved as read.

The Fire Chief's monthly report was read and ordered filed.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Mourer that \$50.00 be appropriated for the Fire Chief's expenses in attending the State Convention of Fire Chiefs at Medford June 24th, 25th and 26th. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Roberts that the purchase of a 14 inch lawn mower be authorized. Motion carried and so ordered.
