

COUNCIL CHAMBERS, JUNE 28, 1937

The four hundred forty-fifth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 28th day of June, 1937.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sanders. Present: Mayor Sanders, Councilmen Burdick, Dell, Mourer and Roberts, Water Superintendent Bevington, Fire Chief Lewellyn and Recorder Adams.

Vote canvassed: The returns of the Special Election held on the 28th day of June, 1937, at which what is known as the "City Hall Amendment", being an amendment to the Charter of Milwaukie, designated as "Section 22 - C", and proposed by the Council, was submitted to the voters of Milwaukie for their acceptance or rejection, were presented and canvassed in accordance with Section 10 of the Town Charter with the following results being had:

It was moved by Mourer and seconded by Dell that C. E. Altman be awarded the contract for painting and trimming the City Water Pumphouse for \$69.95. Motion carried and so ordered.
