

COUNCIL CHAMBERS JULY 25, 1938

The four hundred seventieth meeting of the Council was held on the 25th day of July, 1938 in the Council Chambers, Milwaukie City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Burdick. Present: Mayor Burdick, Councilmen Dell, Kirkpatrick, Ledding, Roberts and Mourer; Water Superintendent Bevington, Marshal Stanley, Fire Chief Lewellyn and Recorder Adams.

The Librarians semi-annual report was read and ordered filed.

The resignations of Mrs E. W. Kirkpatrick and Mrs E. B. Piper from the Library Board were read. It was moved by Ledding and seconded by Kirkpatrick that the resignation be accepted. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Ledding and seconded by Kirkpatrick that Mrs. George Cooper and Mrs I. McClure be appointed to fill the vacancies existent on the Library Board. Motion carried and so ordered.

Mr. Delmar Randall appeared in behalf of a committee seeking annexation to Milwaukie.

It was moved by Ledding and seconded by Dell that Joseph H. Anderson, contractor, be paid \$14,500.00 on account and that Walter E. Kelly, architect be paid \$310.00 on account, out of the City Hall Fund. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Dell and seconded by Roberts that the Fire Chief be allowed \$50.00 for expense's to the State Fire Chief's convention. Motion carried and so ordered.

Upon motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
