

COUNCIL CHAMBERS, JULY 26, 1937

The four hundred forty-seventh regular meeting of the Council was held on the 26th day of July, 1937.

The meeting was called to order by Acting Mayor Burdick. Present: Councilmen Burdick, Dell, Mourer and Roberts, Water Superintendent Bevington, Marshal Stanley, Fire Chief Lewellyn and Recorder Adams.

A communication from the Clackamas County Planning Board stating that the Board was now on a permanent basis and thanking the City for its cooperation in the past was read. It was moved by Dell and seconded by Mourer that the Recorder acknowledge the letter and commend the Planning Board for its work. Motion carried and so ordered.

Emil C. Kroll requested that the Council endorse his application to the State Liquor Control Commission for a beer license. A petition from the Evangelical Church opposing the granting of beer licenses in Milwaukie was read. Rev. Mr. Lovett, who presented the petition, stated that the petition was not addressed particularly to Mr. Kroll's application.

It was moved by Roberts and seconded by Dell that the request of Mr. Kroll for the favorable endorsement of the Council on his beer license application be denied. Motion carried and so ordered.

Ordinance No. 379 entitled: "An Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of Milwaukie City Hall Bonds in the sum of Seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000.00) dated as of August , 1937, of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon." was taken up for consideration and read for the first and second times.

Upon motion duly made and carried the meeting adjourned.
