

COUNCIL CHAMBERS SEPTEMBER 26, 1938

The four hundred seventy-fourth regular meeting of the Council was held on the 26th day of September, 1938.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Burdick. Present: Mayor Burdick, Councilmen Kirkpatrick, Ledding, Mourer and Roberts, Water Superintendent Bevington, Marshal Stanley, Fire Chief Lewellyn and Recorder Adams.

It was moved by Ledding and seconded by Roberts that Joseph H. Anderson, Contractor, be paid \$4,500.00 on the amount owing him on the construction of the new City Hall.

It was moved by Ledding and seconded by Roberts that the City purchase six oil-burning circulator heaters. Motion carried and so ordered.

It was moved by Ledding and seconded by Kirkpatrick that the City trade the old Recorder's safe to School District No. 1 for a sink. Motion carried and so ordered.
