

Milwaukee Oct 8th (1883)

The 10th Meeting of the Common Council was called together by Mayor Shindler. The roll call showed those present were Messrs Roberts = Kees & Keller absent Reed = present Treasurer McLean = Marshall Rich & Recorder Lechner

Mayor Calla for a report on Bridges
Mr Roberts said he had no report to make

Mayor said he had found on Examining Bridge over Slew Waste. it was not safe & he ordered it repaired. He took Mr. Dively with him & fixed it at a cost of \$ 23.³⁸

Keller made a motion
2^d by Kees to Except report of Mayor Shindler & Committee be discharged Carried

* Under Head of New Business
Mr Roberts motion = 2^d by Keller that we gravel sidewalk from Lechner's Bridge on (now Harrison) St north side of St west to Strider Gate at a cost not to exceed \$20.⁰⁰ Carried

Mr Keller said there was a lot of Lumber in the lower end of Town which might be had for still asking - which would be just the thing for cross walks it was owned by the citizens several were in the Council =

The Mayor said regarding the lumber to have the Committee on Sts to see the parties owning the lumber & get their consent to use it; for cross & side walks;

x Mr Kerr said it was a hard proposition to get Sts fixed = he had a partition going around = but there were so many widows living on main st that all seemed to object to putting out a Cent for st improvements;
Mr Sigbee wanted his side walk put down in front of his house = but Mrs Quants fence was out in the middle of the st, in front of his house;

x Mr Kees presented a petition to have a fence removed which he declared was dangerous and a nuisance to pedestrians. Said fence was put up by one J C Hall on premises known as the Bishop property = said fence is said to project over a side walk; in such a manner as to obstruct any one from passing without danger of an accident; it was signed by the following citizens

Mr Roberts said he understood the situation exactly & he was never better prepared to report on it than now
 Mr Roberts moved 2nd by Res. that he be notified by necessary checks to move said fence within 30 days
