

Milwaukee Or Oct 22<sup>d</sup> 1903

The 11<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Common Council was called together by Mayor Shinden. The roll call showed those present were Councilmen Roberts, Kerr & Keller. absent Reed.

A communication was read from J. C. Hall requesting the Mayor to locate his line so as to build a fence & not interfere with our streets as laid out according to our City Charter. referred to Street Committee.

A bill of the amount \$4.05 for labor on bridge work also one from Mr. Slipp @ 6 for warrants & complaints. Opinions etc of repairing bridges & etc \$2.50 ordered paid.

Marshall Kerk reported a sewer emptying in one of our streets by Mr. Holsch = referred to Health & Police Committee.

Mayor reported four persons brought up for peddling without a license. Two were discharged without paying = Cushing & Wicks paid \$1.00 same was given to Mr. Kerk for making arrest.

Mayor said that he knew a lot of people here that never had paid their Poll Tax. a list of all the voters in this district should be made out & given to the Marshall = & those that have not paid should be made to pay. referred to Finance Committee.

The Mayor said it was time to appoint two Clerks + 3 Judges for our next Election; + the Council had the appointing =

The officers were then appointed by the Council = for Judges Mr J R Kees  
 J Adwelling J R a Delwood  
 Clerks Dock Reed = Fred Wheeler

Mr Kerr stated that a majority along main St had signed a petition for side walks.

Mr Reid having been absent for more than 30 days his office was declared vacant!

It was moved by Roberts 2d by Kerr that City Atty be consulted about side walks + poll tax.

Mr Kees said he was appointed on committee of side walks but on account of his work was unable to attend to same.

Marshall Keck was requested to see people owning lumber pile and ask them to donate it + City would lay it at City's expense.
