

Milwaukie, Ore. Sept. 11, 1906

The 53d meeting of the common Council was called to order by Mayor Shindler

Councilmen present were, Streib, Webster, Kivly & Matthews, Treasurer Lehman and Marshal Mc Caulley.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

A communication from the North-western Telephone and Telegraph Co. concerning franchise, and on motion by Webster, which was carried was ordered laid on the table.

Bills of Portland General Electric Co \$37.40 and J. M. Snyder \$3.00 ~~00~~ were ordered paid.

It was reported that bridge near Keck's residence was in bad condition and it was stated by Mayor Shindler that the lumber had been ordered.

It was stated by the mayor that the City hall would cost more than at first expected and on motion by Streib, which was carried the finance committee was authorized to borrow the sum of \$400.00.

Funds received ^{for fines for parking} were \$1.00 from Phil Spiegel. It was moved and carried that marshal receive fifty cents of Money collected.
