

Town Hall, Milwaukee. Wis.

Aug 11, 1908

The 77 regular meeting was called to order by Mayor Shindler.
Councilmen present. were Phil Strip Os. Matthews
J.R. Kelso and T.R. A. Sellwood.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Bill of O. Wissniger for Rope for flag pole \$4.65
Mails 90¢ was read.

On motion the bill was reduced to \$3.60 ✓
on account of allowance made by council
at a previous of \$27.5 for pole rope.

This bill with which was included \$42.40
for Putnam Genl Electric for street lighting
was allowed and warrants ordered drawn on
the treasurer for the amounts.

A communication to the council from Mayor
Shindler which contained the veto of
ordinance No. 25 was read.

Councilman Strip moves that the Ordinance
be passed and was seconded by J.R. Kelso.

The roll was called and Strip answered
yes Os. Matthews no. J.R. Kelso yes T.R. A. Sellwood
The motion was carried.

A proposition from W. W. Cornsall to grade
and gravel Webster's hill was read.

to cut and grade the same \$35.00
to deliver and spread gravel \$1.00 per yard
to deliver and spread washed gravel \$1.35 per yard
Councilman Kelso reported the bridge near
Phil Strip in bad condition, which was
ordered repaired.

The proposition of Cornsall to grade and Gravel
Webster's hill was accepted and Com. on streets and
public property were given privilege to choose
either of the two kinds of gravel to be used.

on motion mayor Shredder was instructed to pay J. M. Snyder one half of the cost of finishing the interior of City Hall.

Mr Will Gracie appeared before the council asking what might be done to establish a grade and to place a side walk leading toward his place along the Oregon City road.

On motion this matter was referred to the committee on streets and public property on motion the council adjourned.
