Bill of Portland Ry Light & Power for meters lighting was held over Council holding that the city was entitled to the new rate enjoyed in Portland of $2\frac{1}{2}$ cts per K. W. hr instead of the 15 cts as charged.

On motion by Councilman Mullan the communication from the Portland Automobile Club was placed on file.

Councilman Kelso made a few remarks along the line of keeping the streets more clean from rubbish, wood etc and remarked further that we had no ordinance covering the obstructing of

Streets, and after some discussion by members of the council it was decided to have an ordinance drawn covering same, and including thistles growing in front of property, and cord wood and other material piled in front of property on the streets. said ordinance to be prepared for the consideration of the council at its next meeting.
