

Town Hall April 13th 1900

The 84th Regular meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Streib. Councilman present were Kelso, Sellwood, Mullanrd Lehman, Deputy Marshal Geo Van Vleet Recorder Dowling

be continued untill April 20th to
give Ry Co time to prepare plans of
