

Town Hall Milwaukee W., March 12, 1907

The 59 regular meeting of the common council of Milwaukee was called to order by Mayor Schindler.

Councilmen present were Phil. Streif, Geo. Hively, O. S. Matheson.

M. F. Lehman, Recorder, and J. C. Elkins were present.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

Committee on Fire and water reported the purchase of supplies for fire department. Bills read as follows:

Orrland Genl Electric \$37<sup>12</sup> reduced to \$12<sup>37</sup>  
A. G. Long. Buckets and axes for fire department \$900

Milwaukee Merc. Co. Lanterns 200 Ropes 200  
Frank Newton for ladder for fire department \$12<sup>85</sup>

On motion all bills were allowed as read. Communication from A. G. Long, stating that the style of buckets ordered by the fire committee were unavailable and that another style had been substituted, was ordered placed on file.

Communication from Warren Munroe, publishing company, in regard to Mill site was ordered placed on file.

Petition to build sidewalk commencing on the southwest corner of J. C. Emmel residence and continuing east to a point opposite J. M. Snyder lot, was read.

Petition was ordered laid on the table.

Councilman Streif moved that the Town build cross walk from northeast corner of Mrs. Lewelling block across main street and that committee on street and public property confer with Mrs. Lewelling in regard to

building a sidewalk along the north end of her block.

On motion it was ordered that the sum of \$500 per night be charged for the use of the Town Hall.

On motion the council adjourned.
