

Milwaukie, Ore. Mar. 12, 1906

The 47th meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Shindler.

Those present were Councilmen Streib, Kirby & Matthews, Treasurer Lehman and marshal Dowling; Councilman Webster and Recorder Cooper being absent.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

The following bills were allowed:
A. H. Dowling for posting ordinance No 18, 45 etc. Portland General Electric Co. \$37.10.

Grant Barker was nominated to succeed himself as road commissioner and was unanimously elected.

Mayor Shindler advised that work on the city hall be commenced, stating that it would take several months to complete the work.

Receipts were, from A. H. Dowling, poll tax \$6.00, from licence \$2.00, from poll tax \$3.00 from Portland general Electric Co. \$5.00.

It was moved, and seconded that mayor appoint committee to work out plans for city hall. Mayor appointed finance committee.

A petition praying council to licence and impound dogs.

was read. was moved that the petition be carried over until next meeting, carried.

The fire company was discussed and representation referred to finance committee.

It was moved and seconded to adjourn untill April, 9, 1906.
