

Town Hall. February 12 1907

The 58 meeting of the common council of Milwaukie was called to order by Mayor Schindler.

Councilmen present were Phil Streip
Geo Hively O S Matheson and G N Barker
W F Lehman Rec. E J Erlmer Treas.

J C Elkins Marshall were present.

minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved.

To Hart & Mullan sawing wood 30⁰⁰

To Chas Hively as read on previous meeting \$32.⁴²

It was moved by councilman Hively that all bills be paid as read less reduction of \$5⁰⁰ to Portland Genl Electric Co on account of lack of service and except the bill of Chas Hively of \$32.⁴².

Motion was carried and bills ordered paid
Messrs Hart and Mullan appeared before the council in regard to woodsaw license.

It was moved that the motion instructing the marshal to notify Hart and Mullan woodsaw to pay license be reconsidered.
motion was carried.

Motion of councilman Streip that licensing all wood saws be discontinued was carried
communication from Graton and Apple gate requesting that saloon license for their bar be transferred to the Milwaukie Country Club was read

on motion the request was granted and the recorder instructed to issue new license of communication from the Milwaukee Glee Club requesting that a three year lease of the upper Hall be given the Club for the purpose of giving entertainments,

Moved by Councilman Hirsh that communication be laid over until next meeting. the motion was lost.

Moved by Councilman Strip that lease requested by the Glee Club be granted upon Roll call Councilmen Strip Responds yes. Hirsh yes O S Mathews yes G. N. Barker yes. Motion was carried.
