Ordered that all bills be paid as read
on motion the bill of Constant Gen'l Electric
was ordered reduced in the sum of \$53⁰⁰
on account of bad service. leaving a
balance of \$79⁵⁰ for street lighting for
December 1907, and January 1908, and
ordered paid.

The Health and Water Committee reported that
unsanitary conditions existed back of
the Barber shop and Johnson's restaurant
on motion the the Health and water
com. was instructed to suppress these
conditions.

The Street and Public Property Com. reported
the Fisher bridge in bad condition.

On motion the Street and Public Properties
com. was instructed to advertise for bids
for building a new bridge in place of
the old Fisher bridge. The bids to be
submitted at the next regular meeting.
On motion the Finance was empowered
to purchase one hundred additional feet
of hose for the fire company.

Moved and seconded that the ground east
of the school house and owned by the town
be allowed to the school children for
agricultural purposes. Motion carried
