

Town Hall Milwaukee Cr.
 Jan 14-1908

The 70th regular meeting of the common council was called to order by Mayor Sprindler.

Councilmen present were Ch. Strup, O. S. Mathews, J. R. Kelso and T. R. A. Sellwood. Recorder W. F. Lehman Treas. E. J. Elmer were present.

Minutes of previous regular and special meetings were read and approved.

In his annual message to the council Mayor Sprindler recommended the completion of the City Hall.

and urged the council to work for better sanitary conditions. Stating that in the controversy of the "Greif" cesspool he had so far done what he had considered for the best, and believed according to the communication from the state health board, such cesspools should not be permitted to exist.

The mayor believed that the committee ^{street} on public property, had been inactive in the work assigned to it, and should take more interest in the expenditure of the road funds, so that the best results might be obtained. Further stating, that a regular monthly report should be submitted to the council.

In concluding his remarks Mayor Sprindler stated that no member of the council could know what was before it but whatever came each member should his best, and success would crown the efforts of the administration.

The committee on Light and water reported that fourteen nights the light

had failed to burn, this during the month of December, and that the committee had brought the matter before the Light company, which stated ~~stated~~ was glad to hear the complaint so that they could improve their service.

On motion it was resolved that the recorder should be notified any time the light did not burn, and that the recorder should report same to the Electric company.

Committee on Streets and public property reported the bridge near Fisher Cottage in a dangerous condition.
