

Ordinance No 15 relating to improvements of main Street

The Town of Hillsboro does ordain as follows

Whenever any owner of property on main Street in the Town of Hillsboro shall cover the ditch in front of his premises on said street he shall so cover said ditch as follows:

Timbers not less than ten inches ~~thorough~~ shall be placed across the ditch and plank not less than two inches thick shall be firmly nailed or spiked to such timbers and extending lengthwise of the ditch. Such plank covering shall be five feet wide, and eight inches lower than the sidewalk, Provided That aprons may be constructed from the aforesaid covering to the ground at any point where it may be necessary to cross the same with teams
