

Ordinance No. 21

Nov. 98

To provide for temporary vacancies in the office of Marshal

The Town of Hillsboro does ordain as follows

Sec 1

Whenever by reason of a vacancy in the office of Marshal of the Town of Hillsboro, or the absence or disability of such officer or from any other cause there shall be no one to perform the duties of such office the Recorder of the Town of Hillsboro may by an order entered upon the journal of this Board and upon such Recorders Docket appoint any suitable person a special peace officer and such special peace officer shall perform the duties and receive the fees of Marshal of the Town of Hillsboro until the vacancy in said office be filled or the absence cease or disability be removed.

Sec 2

As there is at present no Marshal of said Town this act shall take effect 5 days after its passage.
