

# Ordinance No 23

Relating to Improvement of Washington  
Third <sup>(4)</sup> Base Line Streets

The Town of Hillsboro does ordain as follows.

Section 1. A Tax is hereby levied upon all the real property within the said Town of Hillsboro and adjacent to the following line of proposed Improvement for the purpose of constructing sidewalks as follows to wit; Commencing at the corner of Fifth and Washington Streets, and thence along the South side of said Washington Street to the West Side of Third Street; thence along the West Side of Third Street to Base Line Street; thence along the North side of Base Line Street to the West side of Second Street; and the several owners of said property are hereby required within sixty days from the passage of this Ordinance to construct the above described sidewalks in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No 5.

Section 2. The Street Commissioner of the Town of Hillsboro is hereby required within the above mentioned time to construct all needed crossings for such improvements and in

default of the construction of any such sidewalk by any of the aforesaid property holders the Street Commissioners shall within sixty days thereafter construct the same and shall proceed to collect the expense thereof out of the property so delinquent, by and sale thereof in the same manner as delinquent taxes are collected by the Sheriff.
