

Ordinance No 25

Amending "Ordinance No 20 relating to Licenses"

The Town of Hillaboro does ordain as follows

Section 1. That Sections 2 and 3 of an Ordinance entitled Ordinance No 20 relating to licenses be and the same are hereby repealed, and Section 4 of said Ordinance is amended so as to read as follows "Section 4. Upon petition the Board of Trustees may at any regular meeting grant license for the sale of spirituous and malt liquors within the Town of Hillaboro and upon the applicant filing with the Town Recorder his bond as hereinafter provided, and the Treasurer receipt the Recorder shall issue license for such period not less than six months nor more than one year as may have been paid for.

Section 2. That Section 6 of said Ordinance be amended so as to read as follows. Section 6 - The rate of license shall be as follows For selling spirituous and malt liquors in less quantities than one quart per year \$150.

For selling spirituous and malt liquors in quantities of one quart and upwards per year \$50.

For Billiard Saloon, for each table kept for playing for hire, billiards, pool, pigeon hole, bagatelle or other such game payable quarterly in advance per year \$20.

Theatrical performances and other shows not herein otherwise provided for shall pay for each exhibition or performance \$5.00.

For each exhibition of a circus or menagerie \$10.00.

For each lecture, reading or concert given to public assemblages where money is charged for admission (excepting those of a local nature for charitable purposes \$25.00).

the said Hawkers Peddlers and Hucksters shall pay the sum of \$5.00 per month. Provided license may issue one week for 2.00 and provided further that persons selling newspapers books and periodicals and persons selling articles of their own

manufacture or production shall not be required to pay Peddler license

Section 3) That any person licensed under any ordinance of this Town who shall sell give or otherwise dispose of spirituous or small liquors to any minor or insane person or person who may have been under the Statutes of this State or ~~any~~ Ordinance of this Town declared a spendthrift or drunkard shall forfeit his license

Section 4) If any person shall engage in any business or open or begin any show concert lecture or entertainment made subject to license by any ordinance of this Town without having first paid for and obtained a license therefor it shall be the duty of the Marshal of the Town of Hillston to demand of such person the amount of such license and collect the same with an addition of \$1.00 as his fee, and in default of such payment the Marshal shall immediately lay an information against the person so offending.

Section 5) This Ordinance shall take effect five days after its passage.
