

Ordinance No. 102

An ordinance providing for a sidewalk and crossings on the North side of Washington Street, in Hillsboro, Oregon.

The town of Hillsboro, Oregon does ordain as follows:

Sect. 1

That a sidewalk and crossings be built on the North side of Washington Street in Hillsboro, Oregon, commencing at the point where the North side of said Washington Street intersects the East side of Third Street in said town, and running thence East on said North side of Washington Street to intersect the West side of 7th Street in said town.

Sect. 2

The owners of the property adjacent to the line of sidewalk required by Section one of this ordinance are hereby required to complete the same within sixty days from the time this ordinance takes effect.

Sect. 3

If any owner or owners of property adjacent to the aforesaid line of improvements shall fail or neglect to construct the aforesaid sidewalks as provided in this ordinance it shall be the duty of the Street Commissioner to immediately construct the same and he shall collect the expense thereof from the owner or owners of such property so delinquent by a civil action in his own name and shall recover in addition to his per diem 25 per centum of the amount of costs and expenses so incurred by him and to be added to the cost of construction and collected in such action.
