

An Ordinance for making street improvements on West Maple Street, in the City of Hillsboro, Oregon, from the center line of Range Street to the East line of Broadway Street, prescribing the character of material to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said improvement be assessed against the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Hillsboro does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That West Maple Street, in said City, be improved from the center line of Range Street to the East line of Broadway Street, by bringing the surface of the same to the proper grade, paving the roadway with concrete pavement eight feet wide, with rock shoulder 2 feet wide on each side, laying and constructing the same according to the contour of the ground, and by doing such other improvement work as will make a proper and appropriate improvement.

SECTION 2. That the cost and expense of such improvement work be assessed against the lots, or parts thereof, or parcels of land, abutting upon that part of West Maple Street so improved, and that such work be done in the manner prescribed in this ordinance, and as provided by the charter of said City.

SECTION 3. That the City Engineer of said City be and he is hereby directed to estimate and ascertain the whole expense of such improvement, as prescribed in Section 199 of the Charter of said City, and report the same to this council within ten days from the passage of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Inasmuch as the above mentioned improvement is necessary for the public convenience, health, peace and safety of said City, and it is necessary that the same be done without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
