

ORDINANCE NO. 939

An Ordinance assessing the cost of construction of concrete sidewalk in the City of Hillsboro, Oregon, as follows: A concrete sidewalk beginning at the curb 19.5 feet west of the northwest corner of Block 2, Simmons' Addition to the Town (now City) of Hillsboro, Oregon, thence east parallel to the south line of Oak Street 159.2 feet,

more or less, to and connecting with the present concrete sidewalk: Also beginning at a point one foot north of the northwest corner of said Block 2 and extending thence south, parallel to the east line of First Street, 189.4 feet, more or less, to and connecting with the present concrete sidewalk: also beginning at a point 6 feet north of the northwest corner of said Block, of and in said Simmons' Addition, and extending thence north, parallel to the east line of First Street, 13.5 feet, more or less, to the curb, all of said above described sidewalks to constitute one connected sidewalk upon the real property benefitted by said sidewalks and which real property is herein-after in this ordinance particularly described, and providing that said assessed cost of construction be entered in the Docket of City Liens of said City, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Hillsboro does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following bounded and described lots, tracts or parcels of land abutting upon the concrete sidewalks described in the title of this ordinance, and also in this section: A concrete sidewalk beginning at the curb 19.5 feet west of the northwest corner of Block 2, Simmons' Addition to the Town (now City) of Hillsboro, Oregon, thence east, parallel to the south line of Oak Street, 159.2 feet, more or less, to and connecting with the present concrete sidewalk: Also beginning at a point one foot north of the northwest corner of said Block 2 and extending thence south, parallel to the east line of First Street 189.4 feet, more or less, to and connecting with the present concrete sidewalk: also beginning at a point 6 feet north of the northwest corner of said Block, of and in said Simmons' Addition, and extending thence north, parallel to the east line of First Street, 13.5 feet, more or less, to the curb, all of said above described sidewalks to constitute one connected sidewalk, be and the same is hereby assessed with its share of the entire cost and expense of construction of the above described sidewalks, the construction of which is prescribed by Ordinance No. 913 of said City of Hillsboro, Oregon, entitled "An Ordinance providing for construction of a concrete sidewalk in the City of Hillsboro, Oregon, as follows: A concrete sidewalk beginning at the curb 19.5 feet west of the southwest corner of Block 2, Simmons Addition to the Town (now City) of Hillsboro, Oregon, thence east parallel to the south line of Oak Street, 159.2 feet, more or less, to and connecting with the present concrete sidewalk: also beginning at a point one foot north of the northwest corner of said Block 2 and extending thence south parallel to the east line of First Street, 189.4 feet, more or less, go and connecting with the present concrete sidewalk: also beginning at a point 6 feet north of the northwest corner of said Block, of and in said Simmons' Addition, and extending thence north, parallel to the east line of First Street, 13.5 feet, more or less, to the curb, all of said above described sidewalks to constitute one connected sidewalk, requiring the owners of lots, tracts, or parcels of land abutting upon said sidewalks to construct the same, at their own expense, within the time prescribed herein and in conformity with Ordinance No. 901 of said City of Hillsboro, providing that if said owners fail to construct said sidewalks within the time prescribed the same shall be constructed by the City Engineer of said City, and at the expense of the lots, tracts or parcels of land abutting thereon, and declaring an emergency," passed and approved on July 10, 1929, and which said entire cost and expense amounts to the sum of \$362.06 and which was apportioned by the City Council of said City as follows:

The north 60 feet of Lot 5, Block 2, Simmons' Addition to the Town (now City) of Hillsboro, Oregon.

Louis Lomax and Dessie Lomax 56.73

The north 60 feet of Lot 6, Block 2, Simmons' Addition to the Town (now City) of Hillsboro, Oregon.

Louis Lomax and Dessie Lomax 143.93

The west 18 feet of the north 60 feet of Lot 4, Block 2, Simmons' Addition to the Town (now City) of Hillsboro, Oregon.

Louis Lomax and Dessie Lomax 16.08

A tract consisting of parts of Lots 4, 5 and 6, Block 2, Simmons' Addition to the Town (now City) of Hillsboro, Oregon, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point 60 feet south of the N. W. corner of said Block 2 and running thence south 60 feet; thence east 138 feet; thence north 60 feet; thence west 138 feet to place of beginning.

F. L. Chase, 77.28

A tract of land consisting of parts of Lots 4, 5 and 6, Block 2, Simmons Addition to the Town (now City) of Hillsboro, Oregon, and more particularly described as follows: Being the south 1/3 of Lots 4, 5 and 6, of said Block 2, Simmons' Addition, and also the west half of the vacated alley on the east side of said portions of said lot 4,

such owners having failed to pay such apportionment after having been notified thereof more than 15 days prior to the passage and approval of said ordinance.

Section 2. That the Recorder of said City be and is hereby directed to enter a statement of said assessed costs in the Docket of City Liens of said City, as provided by the Charter thereof.

Section 3. Inasmuch as it is necessary for the public convenience health, peace and safety of said City that said costs of construction be assessed and collected without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
