✓ ORDINANCE NO. 1208

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REPAIR OF THE CONCRETE SIDEWALK IN FRONT OF THE PROPERTY HEREINAFTER DESCRIFED IN THE CITY OF HILLSBORO; REQUIRING THE OWNER OF THE PROPERTY ABUTTING THEREON TO REPAIR THE SAME: DESIGNATING THE TYPE OF REPAIR; AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO REPAIR THE SAME AND CHARGE THE COST AGAINST THE ABUTTING PROPERTY UPON FAILURE OF THE OWNER TO REPAIR; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF HILLSBORO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described sidewalk, in the City of Hillsboro, be and the same hereby is ordered to be repaired by the owner of the parcel of land abutting thereon within 30 days after the passage of this Ordinance. Said sidewalk to be repaired is that sidewalk existing in front of the following described property owned by the person whose name follows the description:

Beginning at the N.E. corner of Lot 16, Block 1, of Oak Grove Addition to the City of Hillsboro, Oregon; Thence W. 75'; Thence S. 198.75 feet; Thence E. 75 feet to the S.W. corner of Lot 13, Block 1, of Oak Grove Addition to the City of Hillsboro; Thence N. 198.75 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2: That the sidewalk hereinabove ordered to be repaired shall be repaired under the supervision and control and subject to the specifications and approval of the City Engineer of the City of Hillsboro and shall be, when repaired, five (5) feet wide and four (4) inches thick and constructed of sand, gravel, and cement, and constructed in conformity with the provisions of Ordinance No. 1010 of said City, being an ordinance entitled:

> "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR OF CONCRETE SIDEWALKS, DRIVEWAYS, AND CURBS IN THE CITY OF HILLSBORO, OREGON; REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 701 AND 901 OF SAID CITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

which ordinance was passed and approved on the 8th day of November, 1934. Section 3: Should the owner hereinabove described fail to repair said sidewalk as herein required, the City Engineer be and he hereby is ordered and directed to repair the same and report the cost thereof to the City Council after completion of the work.

Section 4: The City Recorder is hereby ordered and directed to give notice of the passage of this ordinance and of the requirements hereof in reference to the sidewalk to the persons and in the time and manner required by the Charter of the City of Hillsboro as amended.

Section 5: Inasmuch as it is necessary to the public convenience, peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Hillsboro that said sidewalk be repaired without delay to remove a hazard to the traveling public, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
