AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF HILLSBORO.

WHEREAS, all of the owners of the following described property, to-wit:

Beginning at the N.E. corner of Lot 30, Hillsboro Acres, a plat of record in Section 32, T1N, R2W, W.M. and running thence westerly along the north line of said Lot 30 and the westerly extension thereof 501.2 feet, more or less to the easterly corporate boundary of the City of Hillsboro; thence southerly 432.72 feet more or less, along the said easterly City boundary to a point in the center of County Road No. 1418, thence easterly along the center of County Road No. 1418, 501.22 feet to the S.E. corner of said Lot 30, Hillsboro Acres; thence northerly along the east line of said Lot 30, 437.84 feet more or less to the place of beginning. Containing 5.0 acres, more or less.

have filed with the City Recorder of the City of Hillsboro, a written consent that such real property be annexed to the City of Hillsboro, copies of which consent is attached hereto, and,

WHEREAS, said real property is contiguous to the territory of the City of Hillsboro, and,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1850 has heretofore been passed declaring an election within the City shall not be held, and,

WHEREAS, a hearing was held on the question of annexation on the third day of October, 1961, and no objections have been voiced to said annexation.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HILLSBORO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the said territory hereinbefore described is hereby declared to be annexed to the City of Hillsboro, and the City of Hillsboro is hereby directed to make and submit to the Secretary of State of the State of Oregon a copy of this Ordinance together with a copy of the written consent of the owners of the above described territory herein annexed to the City, and also a copy of the Ordinance declaring no election shall be required within said City.
