AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN ASSESSMENT UPON EACH LOT, TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND ABUTTING UPON N.E. GRANT STREET FROM THE WESTERLY LINE OF THE R. WILLIAMS D.L.C. NO. 42 EASTERLY 1,605.3 FRET MORE OR LESS, TO THE WESTERLY LINE OF N.B. CORNELL ROAD IN THE CITY OF HILLSBORD, OREGON, OF LTS PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF THE WHOLE COST AND EXPENSES OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF SAID STREET; DIRECTING THAT SAID ASSESSED COST BE ENTERED IN THE DOCKET OF CITY LIENS OF SAID CITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

In the matter of the assessment of costs of improving N.E. Grant Street from the westerly line of the R. Williams D.L.C. No. 42 easterly 1,605.3 feet, more or less, to the westerly line of N.E. Cornell Road in the City of Hillsboro as provided by Ordinance No. 2070, passed by the Council on the 1st day of March, 1966 authorizing the improvement of said street and providing for the assessment of the cost thereof against the abutting and benefited properties in accordance with the provisions of the amended Charter and Ordinances of the City of Hillsboro, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice published as required by the said Amended Charter a public hearing was held before the City Council at 8 o'clock P.M. on the 2nd day of August, 1966 in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, Hillsboro, Oregon at which time and place all persons were given an opportunity to be heard on the proposed assessment, and,

WHEREAS, it appearing to the Council that no valid objections to such assessment were made or filed with the City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HILLSBORO DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That each lot, tract or percel of land abutting upon or benefited by the improvement of N.E. Grant Street from the westerly line of the R. Williams D.L.C. No. 42 easterly 1,605.3 feet, more or less, to the westerly line of N.E. Cornell Road in the City of Hillsboro, Oregon, be and the same hereby is assessed with its proportionate share of the whole cost and expense of the improvement of said street.

That said street improvement was provided for and prescribed in Ordinance No. 2070, passed by the Council on the 1st day of March, 1966 and approved by the Mayor on the same day, and entitled "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE IMPROVEMENT OF B.E. GRANT STREET FROM THE WESTERLY LINE OF THE R. WILLIAMS D.L.C. NO. 42 EASTERLY 1,605.3 FEET MORE OR LESS, TO THE WESTERLY LINE OF N.E. CORNELL ROAD IN THE CITY OF HILLSBORD, OREGON: DEFINING THE CHARACTER OF THE IMPROVEMENT AND THE MANNER OF PERFORMING THE SAME", introduced and passed on the 1st day of March, 1966 and as apportioned to the property of the City of Hillsboro as follows, to-wit:
