Have a Safe Shopping Spree

- Walk and park only in welllighted areas. Walk confidently and be aware of people around you.
- Always lock your car doors after entering or leaving your car.
- Have your car keys in hand so you don't have to linger before entering your car. Check the back seat and under the car before your get in.
- Never leave your children alone at home, in a car, or in any public place.
- Teach your children that if they get separated from you in a shopping mall, they should go to a cashier and say they are lost.
- Pay with check or credit card when you can. Don't flash your cash.
- Don't leave packages in the car seat. Lock them out of sight in the trunk.

Books for the Homebound


The Ledding Library of Milwaukie is proud to announce an exciting new program—library service to the homebound.


