

RESOLUTION NO. 06-2012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, APPOINTING A CITY PROSECUTOR AND DIRECTING STAFF TO ACCEPT A PROPOSAL AND NEGOTIATE A PERSONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT AT A FIXED PRICE FOR THE TERM OF ONE YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Court for the City of Milwaukie constitutes the City's judicial tribunal and hears cases arising under the Municipal Code, the Development Code, and the Oregon Vehicle Code; and

WHEREAS, The City Prosecutor typically represents the City's interests in cases before the Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the City Council directed staff to review the City Prosecutor contract and consider options for efficiencies; and

WHEREAS, Section 10 of the Milwaukie Charter empowers Council to appoint a City Prosecutor; and

WHEREAS, City staff prepared a Request for Proposals pursuant to Local Rule 70.015(A) (Formal RFP); and

WHEREAS, the City has a need for the services of a person or an entity with particular training, ability, knowledge, and experience as possessed by Rhett Bernstein; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that Rhett Bernstein is qualified and capable of performing professional services as; and


