

CITY OF WEST LINN

RESOLUTION NO. 949-A

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of West Linn, Clackamas County, Oregon, as follows:

SECTION 1. That there shall be held in the City of West Linn, Clackamas County, Oregon on April 13, 1976, a Special Election for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said City at said Special Election, for their approval or rejection, a measure to allow a tax levy in the amount of \$ 497,287.00 in excess of the constitutional six percent limitation set forth in Article XI, Section 11 of the Constitution of the State of Oregon. Said amount is required, and is to be used to meet the costs of operation of departments and functions of the City of West Linn, Oregon, for the Fiscal Year 1976-77.

If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax year will be \$ 146,260.00 more than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the preceding year.

SECTION 2. The recorder of the City of West Linn, Oregon, is hereby authorized and directed to publish notice of said Special Election in a newspaper of general circulation in the City. This notice will be published twice with the first publication at least ten days prior to the date of said Special Election to be held on April 13, 1976. Said notice shall state the date upon which said election shall be held, and shall designate the purpose of said election, the polling places thereof, and the hours said election shall be held.

The recorder of the City of West Linn, Oregon, is hereby ordered and empowered to make all further arrangements and secure the necessary supplies for said election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, there shall be four polling places for said election and such polling places are as follows:

A measure allowing a levy of \$ 497,287.00 in excess of the constitutional six percent limitation, which amount is required, and will be used, to meet the cost of operation of the departments and functions of the City of West Linn, Oregon, for the Fiscal Year 1976-77.




