

RESOLUTION 5-65

WHEREAS, on the 24th day of December, 1964, the President declared a "Major Disaster" in the State of Oregon under the provisions of Public Law 875, 81st Congress, as amended; and


WHEREAS, the City of West Linn is a public entity within said State;

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the City Council of West Linn, Clackamas County, Oregon that the Office of Emergency Planning be and hereby is requested to arrange to have the appropriate Federal Agency perform the following emergency work essential to the health, safety or welfare of the people and property of this public entity:

Emergency bank protection and dredging along the West bank of the Willamette River westerly of Goat Island lying in Section 30, T. 2S., R. 2E., of the Willamette Meridian in Clackamas County, more particularly that river frontage adjacent to the Plat of "Unit D, West Oregon City".


This body certifies that, to the best of its knowledge and belief, the requested work is eligible under Public Law 875, 81st Congress, as amended, and agrees to (a) Provide without cost to the United States all lands, easements, and right-of-way necessary for accomplishment of the approved work; and (b) hold and save the United States free from damages due to the approved work.
