**WHEREAS**, it is fitting and proper to officially recognize the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and



**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE CITY OF WEST LINN** that the week of September 17 through September 23 is


