WHEREAS, THE PUBLIC WORKS SERVICE PROVIDED IN MILWAUKIE ARE AN INTEGRAL PART OF OUR EVERYDAY LIVES, AND

WHEREAS, THE SUPPORT OF AN UNDERSTANDING AND INFORMED CITIZENRY IS VITAL TO THE EFFICIENT OPERATION OF PUBLIC WORKS SYSTEMS AND PROGRAMS SUCH AS WATER, SEWERS, STREETS AND HIGHWAYS; AND THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND COMFORT OF THIS COMMUNITY GREATLY DEPEND ON THESE FACILITIES AND SERVICES, AND

WHEREAS, THE QUALITY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THESE FACILITIES, AS WELL AS THEIR PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION ARE DEPENDENT UPON THE EFFORTS AND SKILL OF PUBLIC WORKS OFFICIALS, AND

WHEREAS, THE EFFICIENCY OF QUALIFIED AND DEDICATED PERSONNEL WHO STAFF PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENTS IS INFLUENCED BY THE PEOPLE'S ATTITUDE AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORK THEY PERFORM.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RONALD KINSELLA, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE DO HEREBY PROCLAIM MAY 19TH THROUGH MAY 25TH, 1985 AS NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK AND CALL UPON ALL CITIZENS AND CIVIC ORGANIZATIONS TO ACQUAINT THEMSELVES WITH PUBLIC WORKS PROGRAMS AND OPERATIONS AND TO RECOGNIZE THE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT PUBLIC WORKS OFFICIALS MAKE EVERYDAY TO OUR HEALTH, SAFETY, AND COMFORT.
