

Town of Fall Milwaukee Wis.

May 12 1908

The 74th regular meeting of the town council was called to order by Mayor Shindler.

Councilmen present were Ch. Strup
O.S. Mathews and J.R. Kels.

W.S. Lehman Recorder and Jess Beck
Marshal were present

Minutes of the previous meeting were
read and approved.

Bills were read as follows:

To J.M. Singer for benches and later $\$16 \frac{91}{100}$
" bill of lumber for bridge work $\$36 \frac{92}{100}$

Marshal posting Ordinances No. 23 and 24 35^x

Portland Genl Electric Co street lighting $\$42 \frac{40}{100}$

On motion all bills were allowed as read
and warrants ordered drawn on the Treas
for the amounts.

On motion a warrant of \$29.00 was ordered
drawn in favor of E.D. Olds for repairing
water way bridge.

The recorder reported rec'd \$4.00 for hall
rent.

Ordinance No. 23 was read, and on
motion of Ch. Strup the ordinance was
taken up for final passage.

The roll was called and Ch. Strup aye
yes. O.S. Mathews yes J.R. Kels yes.

On motion of Councilman Mathews the
rules were suspended and the Ordinance
taken up for the second reading.

Roll was called and Councilman
Strup answered yes O.S. Mathews yes
J.R. Kels yes.

On Motion the rules were suspended and
Ordinance No 23 was taken up for third reading.

Phil Strup answered yes O. S. Mathews
yes and J. R. Kelsay yes.
Ordinance No. 23, passed the third
reading and became a law.

Ordinance No 24 was read and on
motion of Councilman Mathews was
taken up for final passage.
Roll was called and Phil Strup
answered No. O. S. Mathews yes
J. R. Kelsay yes.

On account of the absence of Councilman
Sellers the ^{reading of the} ordinance was continued
until next regular meeting.

On motion the council adjourned
