An Ordinance providing for the governing of the conduct of the patrons and other persons on or around the depots of any railroad or electric cars in West Linn

WEST LINN DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec.1. It shall be unlawful for any person to loiter around any depot or make any disturbance in or around the said depot by using loud or profane language. of any railroad or car

Sec.2. It shall be unlawful for any person to smoke in any waiting room of any railroad in West Linn.

Sec.3. It shall be unlawful for any person to drink any intoxicating liquor in or around any depot of any railroad in West Linn or to have any such liquor in his possession in such place.

Sec.4. Any person found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction in municipal court be fined in any sum not exceeding \$50 or by imprisonment in the city jail for any period not exceeding 25 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
