

RESOLUTION NO. 14-32

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ANNUAL INFLATIONARY ADJUSTMENTS TO THE RATES CHARGED FOR WATER SERVICES

WHEREAS, Oregon City Municipal Code (OCMC) 13.04.260 establishes the setting of water rates by City Commission resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon City Charter, Section 58 establishes that water rates may not be increased by more than three percent annually without a vote of the people; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 09-17 establishing water rates with an expiration date of January 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to adjust rates annually for the effects of inflation so as not to unnecessarily burden customers with unpredictable large rate increases;

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Effective January 1, 2015, and annually thereafter, the monthly rates charged for water provided to each customer serviced by Oregon City shall be adjusted to account for inflation in an amount not to exceed 3 percent.
