

RESOLUTION NO. 4-2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ADOPTING FISCAL YEAR 2000/2001 (YEAR ELEVEN) ANNUAL WASTE REDUCTION PLAN AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN AN IGA WITH METRO.

**WHEREAS**, all local governments within the metropolitan area are required by the State through the leadership of Metro to provide an Annual Waste Reduction Work Plan,

**WHEREAS**, the Waste Reduction Work Plan for the City of Milwaukie is based on the Metro Regional Solid Waste Management Plan (RSWMP), and

**WHEREAS**, Metro has developed a new grant program for commercial recycling called the Commercial Technical Assistance Program which Milwaukie hopes will increase commercial recycling and waste reduction in the City, and


**WHEREAS**, the City recognizes the need and importance of coordinated regional effort to ensure a fair and equitable distribution of the waste reduction efforts in our region,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE** to adopt the attached Fiscal Year 2000-2001 Annual Waste Reduction Plan and to authorize the City Manager to sign an IGA with Metro granting the city \$8,849 in Metro Challenge Funds for implementation of this year's waste reduction tasks and \$10,000 in Commercial Technical Assistance Program funds .


