

RESOLUTION NO. 28-2000

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN A LOCAL AGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ALTER THE RAILROAD-HIGHWAY CROSSING AT HARMONY ROAD.

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon may enter into cooperative agreements with counties and cities for the performance of work on certain types of improvement projects with the allocation of costs on terms and conditions mutually agreeable to the contracting parties; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has existing agreements with Clackamas County to construct, install, and/or maintain traffic control devices and Clackamas County has the forces to construct the ordered improvements for the City of Milwaukie; and

WHEREAS, All parties agree that the proposed crossing alterations are required by the public safety, necessity, convenience and general welfare; therefore


BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie that it hereby authorizes the City Manager to sign a Local Agency Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation which sets forth the framework for obligations by the State and the City and outlines the terms for cooperative interaction between the State and the City in the design and construction of the improvements to alter the railroad highway grade crossing at Harmony Road.


