

ORDINANCE NO. 12-1003

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OREGON CITY AMENDING CHAPTER 5.04 OF THE OREGON CITY MUNICIPAL CODE RELATED TO BUSINESS LICENSES

WHEREAS, the Oregon City Commission has adopted a business licensing program in the City that is designated to raise revenue as well as to ensure that business can be carried on in a safe and reasonable manner; and

WHEREAS, the business licensing code does not currently address whether a business can obtain a license for a business that violates local, state, or federal law; and

WHEREAS, the procedures in the licensing code should be updated to clarify businesses' responsibilities and City requirements.


NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 5.04.060 of the Oregon City Municipal Code is amended to read as follows.

5.04.060 – License – Required.


No person shall carry on any business within the City without first obtaining a license therefor. Nor shall any person carry on any such business without complying with the provisions of this chapter. No license shall issue to any business prohibited by local, state or federal law.

The forgoing ordinance was read for the first time at a regular meeting of the City Commission held on the 21st day of March 2012, and the City Commission finally enacted same this 4th day of April 2012.




