

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Commission has submitted to the people of Oregon City for their approval or rejection an ordinance contained in a resolution filed with the City Recorder on April 13, 1956 to be voted upon at a special city election to be held on May 18, 1956, and

WHEREAS on April 13, 1956 the City Recorder requested the City Attorney to prepare a ballot title for said Ordinance contained in said resolution proposed by the Commission, and

WHEREAS the City Attorney on April 16, 1956 pursuant to the Charter of Oregon City, has provided, returned and filed with the City Recorder ballot title for said measure as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 1430

SPECIAL SEVEN\*YEAR SALARY INCREASE LEVY.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COMMISSION TO LEVY A SPECIAL TAX OF \$25,000.00 EACH YEAR FOR SEVEN SUCCESSIVE YEARS BEGINNING WITH THE FISCAL YEAR 1956-1957 FOR \$30.00 PER MONTH WAGE INCREASE FOR ALL CITY EMPLOYEES AND FOR RETIREMENT, STATE INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENT COMMISSION, SOCIAL SECURITY, VACATION AND SICK LEAVE COVERAGES THEREFOR OUTSIDE CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATIONS.

AND WHEREAS no objections to said ballot title have been filed by any persons

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commission of Oregon City that said ballot title above, be and the same is hereby approved.
