

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-1999**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON,  
SUPPORTING POSSIBLE DEVELOPMENT OF A SKATE PARK.**

**WHEREAS**, we believe that the youth in the communities of Oregon City, Milwaukie, Oak Lodge and Gladstone would benefit from greater recreational opportunities and

**WHEREAS**, we understand that a significant number of these youth have expressed a desire for greater recreation opportunities from development of a locally available skate park and

**WHEREAS**, we believe that a skate park, if constructed, would serve recreational needs on a regional basis and therefore several communities working together on possible development of a skate park would be most appropriate and

**WHEREAS**, we understand that vacant land near Clackamette Park in Oregon City or other nearby location on or near a bus line may be available for a possible skate park and


**WHEREAS**, we understand that grant funds in a yet undetermined amount may be available for planning and perhaps construction of a skate park and

**WHEREAS**, we also understand that planning for a skate park will include developing park design and cost estimates, and determining potential funding sources and

**WHEREAS**, due to the aforementioned circumstances, the Common Council of the City of Milwaukie supports working together with representatives of other communities to potentially develop a skate park at Clackamette Park or other nearby location, subject to further evaluation and decision.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor be authorized to sign this resolution in support of potentially developing a skate park at Clackamette Park or other nearby location,


