

RESOLUTION NUMBER 18-1998

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE amending resolution # 17-1992 to decrease the residential rates by 1.2%, commercial rates by 1.7% and increase the franchise fee for garbage collection franchises from 3% to 5%.

WHEREAS, Section 13 of Ordinance 1752 provides that City Council may set rates and implement rate changes


WHEREAS, Section 14 of Ordinance 1752 provides that City Council may establish, by resolution, franchise fees as compensation for contract rights to franchisees and for the use of City streets.

WHEREAS, the garbage haulers have agreed to the increase in franchise fee and decrease in residential and commercial rates in order to reduce their rate of return.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the rates for residential garbage services be decreased by 1.2% and rates for commercial garbage services be decreased by 1.7%, effective July 1, 1998.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the franchise fee on garbage franchisees be increased from 3% to 5% of gross receipts, effective July 1, 1998.
