**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE OREGON AMENDING  
RESOLUTION NUMBER 17-1992 TO INCLUDE RATES FOR ADDITIONAL  
SERVICES.**


**WHEREAS**, Section 13 of Ordinance 1752 provides that the City Council may set rates to be charged by the garbage franchisees by Council resolution, and

**WHEREAS**, Section 8 of Ordinance 1752 provides that the franchisees shall make available, for subscription, all levels of solid waste collection for which the city sets rates, and


**WHEREAS**, staff and the franchised haulers have identified several services for which no rates exist;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon that Resolution Number 17-1992 is amended to include the rates for additional services set forth in Attachment "A" attached hereto, which is by reference made a part hereof, and that said rates as set forth in the attached Attachment "A" shall be effective on the 1st day of August, 1996.

## ATTACHMENT A

### Proposed Rates

Staff has reviewed the existing rate schedule and found several services for which there are no rates at all. The city code states that haulers “shall make available, for subscription, all levels of solid waste collection for which the city sets rates.” Staff, with the cooperation of the haulers, compared the rates for services provided in Clackamas County with those in Milwaukie, identified those services for which rates were necessary, and has proposed rates for each. Although rates for several services are proposed, there are a few that should be highlighted. These include:

- A **Recycling Only** rate for those residents who do not have garbage collection service but would like to recycle at the curb. Currently, these residents do not pay anything for their recycling service.
- A **Monthly Service** rate. Haulers may offer to provide either monthly service or **On-Call (known as Yoo Hoo)** service. The rate for both these services will be \$5.30 if the customer pays cash at the time of collection and \$6.85 if the customer is billed for the service.
- A rate for **Drop Box Deposits**. Specific deposit amounts can be set by individual haulers but each hauler’s policy must be submitted to the city and a deposit for one box may not exceed \$ 500.00. Deposits for drop boxes function as down payments for the cost of the rental, haul and dumping of drop boxes. Once the service has been provided and the total owed is calculated, the customer is rebated any portion of the \$500.00 owed them or billed the amount that the service cost exceeded the deposit.
