RESOLUTION NO. 101996

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, DECLARING A SPECIAL EMERGENCY UNDER THE CITY'S EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN.

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service, Portland, Oregon has issued a flood warning for the entire Willamette River (attached); and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie is authorized by ORS 401 and the Resolution of the Council adopting the Emergency Operations Plan. "

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE that

1. The City of Milwaukie City Council does hereby find and declare that there is a Special Emergency affecting the areas of the City near the Willamette River, Kellogg Creek, and Johnson Creek confluence; and

2. That there is a need to implement the Cities Emergency Operations Plan for a Special Emergency conferring the necessary powers to the Emergency Program Manager under the plan.

Introduced and adopted by the City Council on this 7th day of February 1996.

...FLOOD WARNINGS ISSUED FOR THE ENTIRE WILLAMETTE RIVER...WITH
POSSIBLE MAJOR FLOODING BY THURSDAY...

...FLOOD WARNING ISSUED FOR THE MCKENZIE RIVER IN LANE COUNTY...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE HAS ISSUED A FLOOD WARNING FOR THE
ENTIRE WILLAMETTE RIVER IN WESTERN OREGON. VERY HEAVY RAIN FOR THE
PAST TWO DAYS HAS CAUSED SHARP RISES AND FLOODING ON NEARLY ALL
WILLAMETTE TRIBUTARIES. THE WILLAMETTE RIVER WILL REACH FLOOD STAGE
AT AREAS FROM HARRISBURG DOWNSTREAM THROUGH SALEM DURING THE DAY
TODAY. THE GAGE AS SALEM IS RISING PARTICULARLY FAST AND SHOULD
REACH FLOOD STAGE BY LATE MORNING. THE RIVER CONTINUE RISING FOR THE
NEXT COUPLE OF DAYS.

IF HEAVY RAIN CONTINUES...POSSIBLE MAJOR FLOOD LEVELS MAY BE REACHED
ALONG THE WILLAMETTE RIVER TONIGHT OR THURSDAY. THOSE LIVING NEAR
THE WILLAMETTE RIVER SHOULD TAKE NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS NOW TO PROTECT
LIFE AND PROPERTY FROM THE RISING RIVER.

FURTHER STATEMENTS WILL BE ISSUED WITH FORECAST RIVER LEVELS AS THEY
BECOME AVAILABLE.
