

RESOLUTION NO. 13-1995

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON,
APPROVING FISCAL YEAR 1995-1996 NORTH CLACKAMAS
PARKS AND RECREATION DISTRICT (NCPRD) MILWAUKIE
NEIGHBORHOOD PARKS FUNDING.**

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with the NCPRD;

WHEREAS, such IGA provides for a total of between \$500,000 and \$800,00 (in 1990 dollars) funding and resources for land acquisition and the development of neighborhood parks facilities within the City of Milwaukie, between 1991 and 1996;

WHEREAS, the NCPRD may undertake improvements to parks currently under the jurisdiction of the City of Milwaukie subject to the approval of the City Council, or it's designee;

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has existing master plans for Ardenwald and Scott Parks;

WHEREAS, in the IGA, the City of Milwaukie has listed as possible projects for neighborhood parks funding the acquisition of land for neighborhood or mini-parks, build neighborhood parks, build mini-parks or vest parks, improve or rehabilitate existing parks, expand existing parks facilities, etc.;

WHEREAS, the Milwaukie Parks and Recreation Commission (PARC) is an advisory commission to the City Council;

WHEREAS, the PARC met on Monday, February 6, 1995, at 7:00 PM and discussed proposed projects and prioritized projects for funding for the NCPRD fiscal year 1995-1996 budget, for Milwaukie neighborhood parks;

WHEREAS, the City Council and the PARC met in a public worksession with NCPRD staff at 5:30 PM on Tuesday, February 21, 1995, to discuss proposed projects for NCPRD funding in fiscal year 1995-1996;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie that the following prioritized list of projects shall receive NCPRD neighborhood parks funds in fiscal year 1995-1996 in the listed priority order:

1. Ardenwald Park -- Complete the master plan as budgeted, including the path that extends along the northern portion of the park.
2. Acquisition -- Acquire the property north of the trestle and west of Kellogg Lake to link with Dogwood Park and acquire sites along the Willamette River.
3. Furnberg Park -- Do not proceed with any construction of this park until a master plan is created. Funds should be dedicated toward a master plan in the 1995-1996 fiscal year.
4. Scott Park -- This project should be funded, however, actual expenditures should not occur until the City is fully aware of the light rail alignment and the financial implications associated with it.
5. Century Park -- Refurbishment of the tennis court should occur in the 1995-1996 fiscal year.


