A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE,  
OREGON,

WHEREAS, Milwaukie has participated in the South/North High Capacity Transit Study; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Management Group and the Steering Committee of elected officials have determined that Light Rail is the best solution for the regions transit needs; and

WHEREAS, the South/North MAX would run 25 to 30 miles from Clackamas County through Milwaukie and Portland, across the Columbia River to Vancouver, and into Clark County Washington; and

WHEREAS, Metro projects that 41,000 more cars will be added to the region's rush hour traffic in the next five years; and

WHEREAS, South/North MAX would help maintain Milwaukie as a good place to live.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that:

The City Council registers its support for South/North MAX Light Rail Measure 26-13 and urges its citizens to vote to maintain Milwaukie's livability.
