

RESOLUTION NO. 47-1994

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AGREEMENTS EXTENDING PICK-UP OF THE EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT CONTRIBUTION AND SICK LEAVE CONVERSION TO NON-REPRESENTED EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, the City wishes to maintain parity in benefits between its employees represented by a labor union and non-represented employees;

WHEREAS, funds for employee retirement contributions have been budgeted for fiscal year 1994-95;


WHEREAS, there is no expectation of any increased level of funding necessary to make retirement contributions in future fiscal years,

WHEREAS, should Ballot Measure 8 fail in November 1994, this agreement will have no impact whatsoever;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to enter into agreements to maintain parity, with no change in employment status or benefit levels for its employees,


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie that the City Manager is authorized to execute the agreements requiring the City to continue making the non-represented employee contribution to retirement accounts and to continue the sick leave conversion at retirement through June 30, 1996.


